

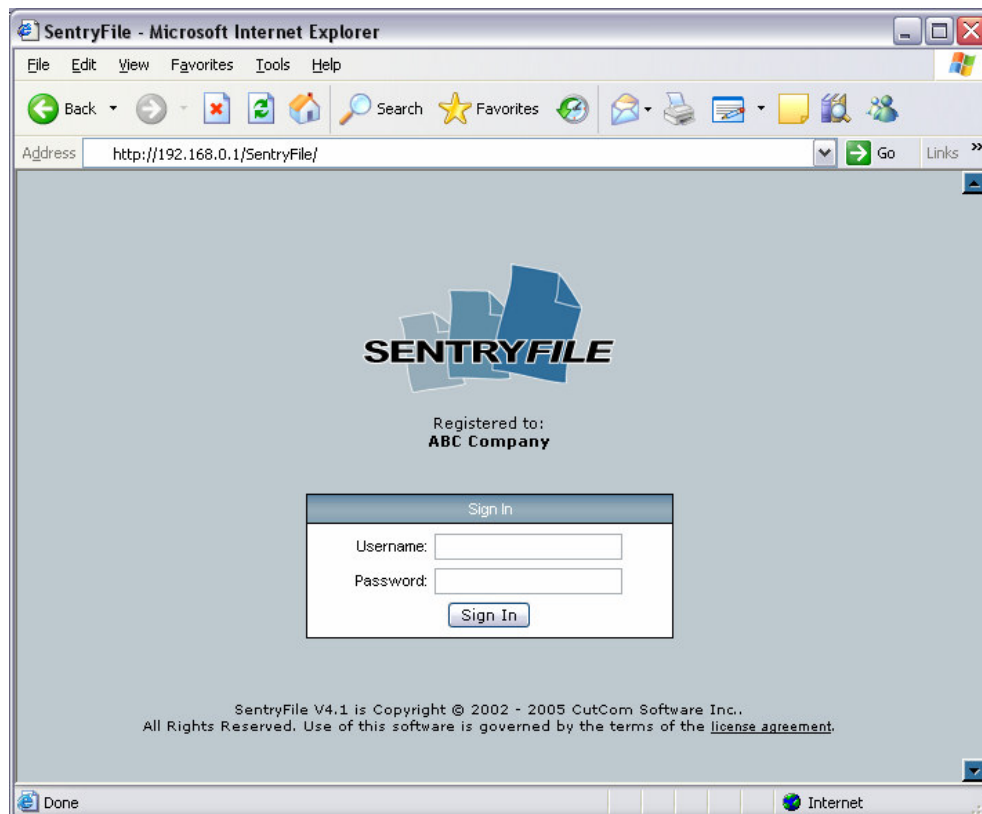
Windows XP Service Pack 2 - Internet Explorer Modifications

Windows XP Service Pack 2 has added numerous security features that may conflict with the normal operation of SentryFile Version 3 and Version 4 (all editions). The new security features are primarily located within Microsoft Internet Explorer included with the Windows XP Service Pack 2 update. This document will walk you through the recommended changes to ensure that SentryFile continues to function as expected.

The security enhancements built into Internet Explorer under service pack 2 can be disabled for certain website. This is done by adding “trusted” websites (like your SentryFile website) to the Internet Explorer “Trusted Sites” lists.

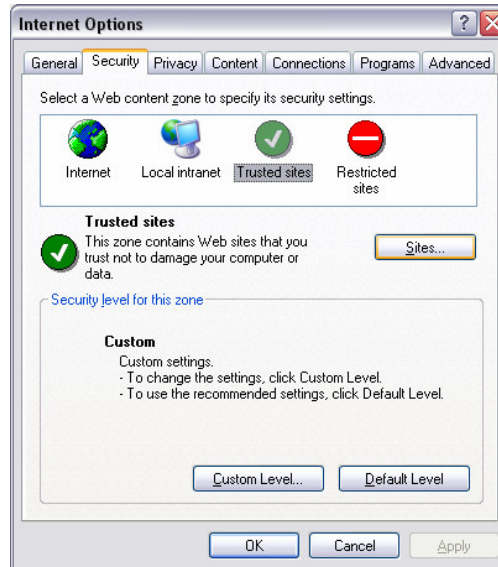
Step 1: Visit the “Sign On” page for your SentryFile system:

Open Microsoft Internet Explorer and navigate to the “Sign On” page of your SentryFile System. Typically the url is something like <http://192.168.0.1/SentryFile/> (This url may be different depending on your IP address naming scheme).

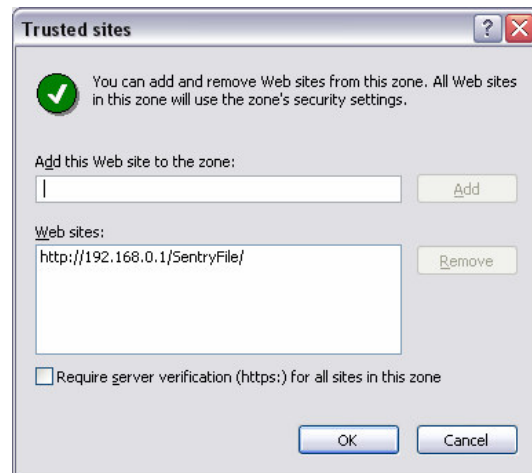
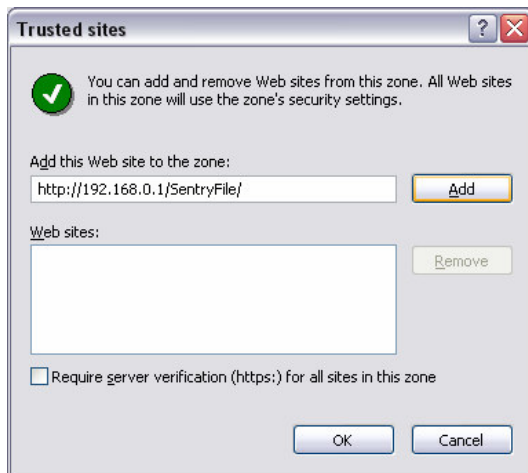


Step 2: Add SentryFile to your “Trusted Sites” list under the “Security” tab:

- In Internet Explorer, click “Tools” -> “Internet Options”
- Click the “Security” tab
- Click the “Trusted Sites” icon
- Click the “Sites...” button

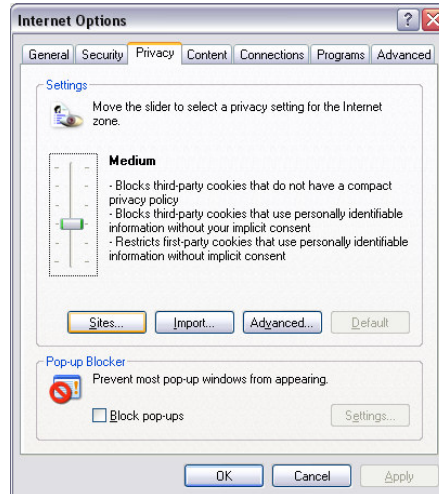


- “Uncheck” the “Require server verification (https:) for all sites in this zone.”
- Enter the SentryFile url (typically <http://192.168.0.1/SentryFile/>) into the “Add this web site to the zone” field. Click the “Add” button
- You will see the url that you entered in the “Web sites” list.
- Click OK to save the changes. (These steps should be repeated for all Windows XP Service Pack 2 Workstations)

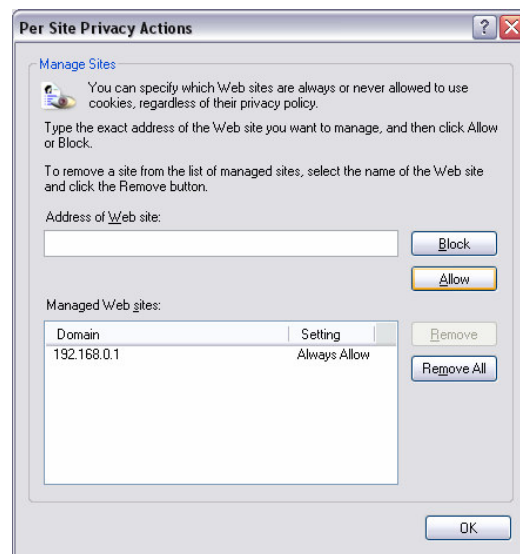
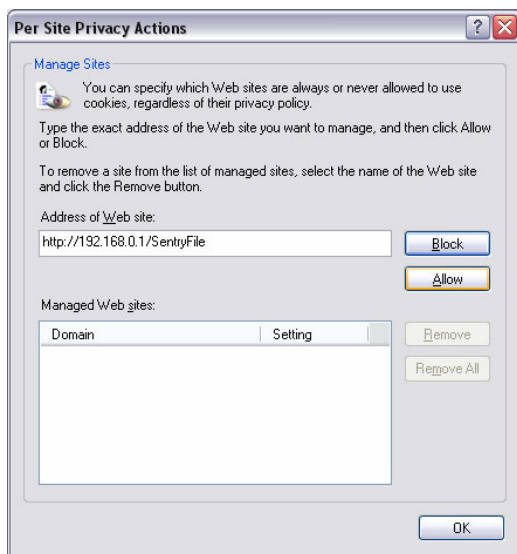


Step 3: Add SentryFile to your “Sites” list under the “Privacy” tab:

- In Internet Explorer, click “Tools” -> “Internet Options”
- Click the “Privacy” tab
- Click the “Sites...” button

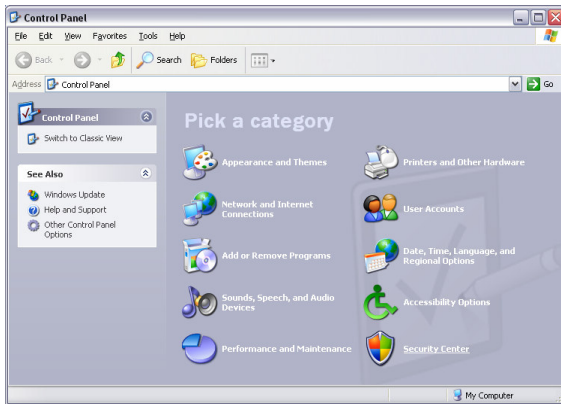


- Enter the SentryFile url (typically <http://192.168.0.1/SentryFile/>) into the “Address of Web site” field. Click the “Allow” button
- You will see the url that you entered in the “Managed Web sites” list.
- Click OK to save the changes. (These steps should be repeated for all Windows XP Service Pack 2 Workstations)

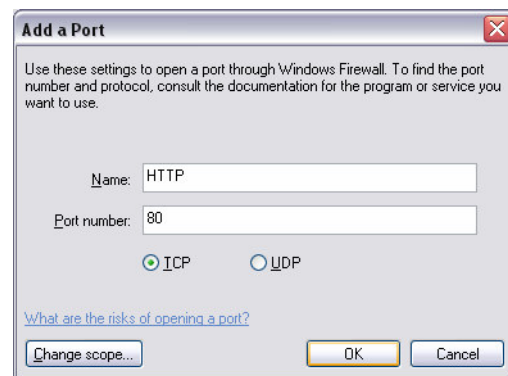
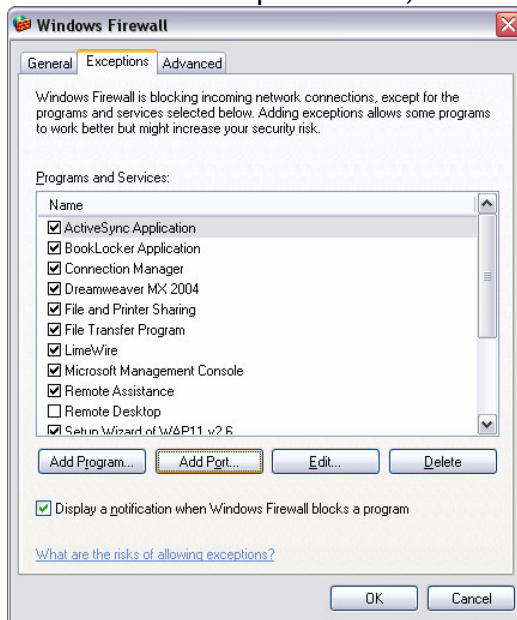


Step 4: (OPTIONAL) This step is only necessary for client who are hosting their SentryFile system on a Windows XP Service Pack 2 computer. Under these conditions it is necessary to enable access through the Windows XP Service Pack 2 Firewall.

- Click “Start” -> “Control Panel”
- Click the “Security Center” icon



- Under the “Manage security settings for:” heading, click the “Windows Firewall” option.
- Click the “Exceptions” tab, and click “Add Port...”



- On the “Add a port” dialog, enter Name as “HTTP” and Port Number as “80”. Select the “TCP” option. Then click “OK” to save the changes.
- Click “OK” again to close the Windows Firewall dialog.
